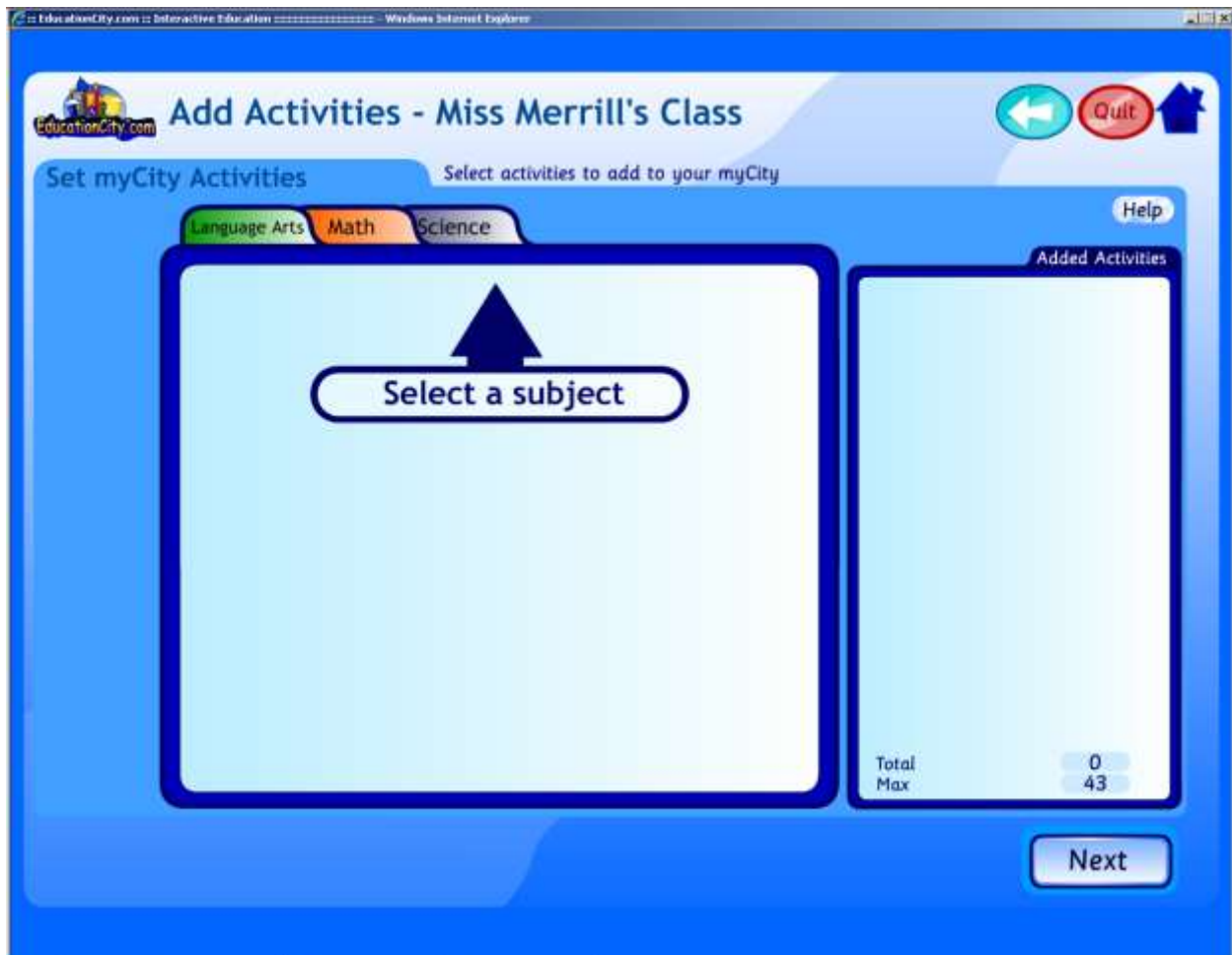

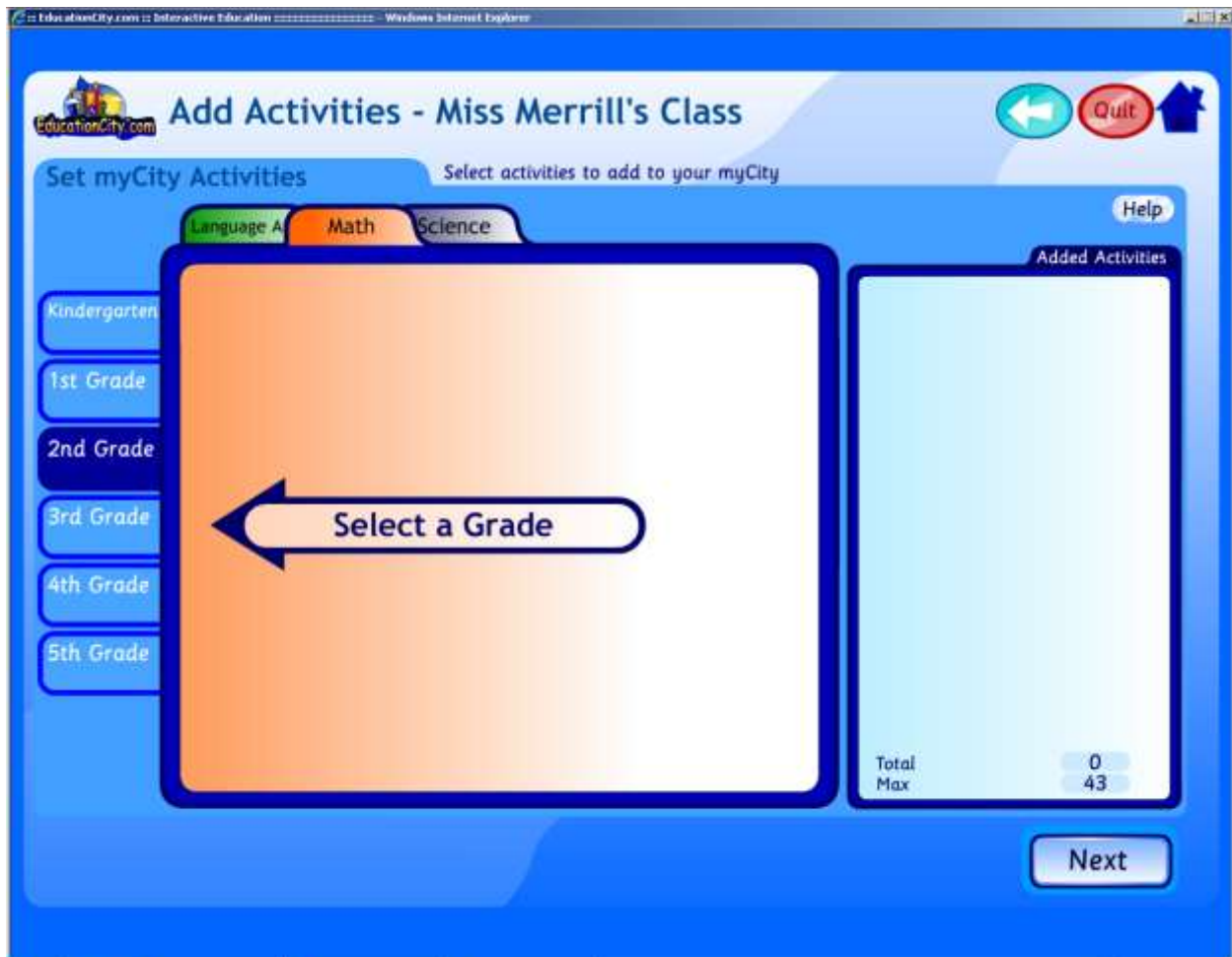
**You can pick a background for your class page on the left, just click the one you want, when finished click NEXT**



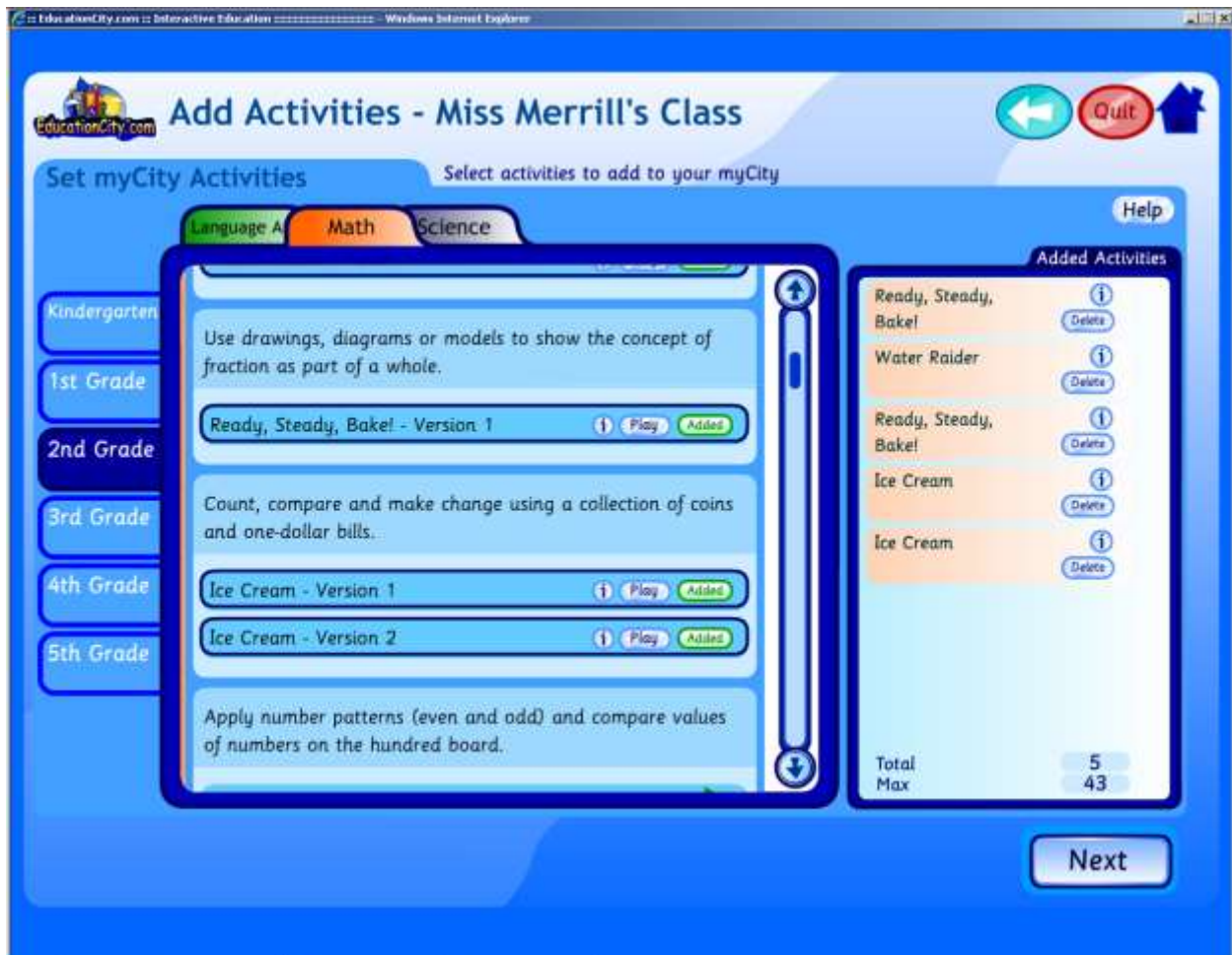
This is where you will add the activities that you want for this city. **CLICK** the center button that says **CLICK TO ADD ACTIVITIES**.

This is where you add what you want in your city. The i with the circle around it gives you the information about that area. The Play of course gives you the option to play it so you can see what it is all about, and the Add puts it in the activities box on the right.

Once you add all that you want for this city – CLICK NEXT.

Notice you can also delete activities within your city when finished with that section if you wish.

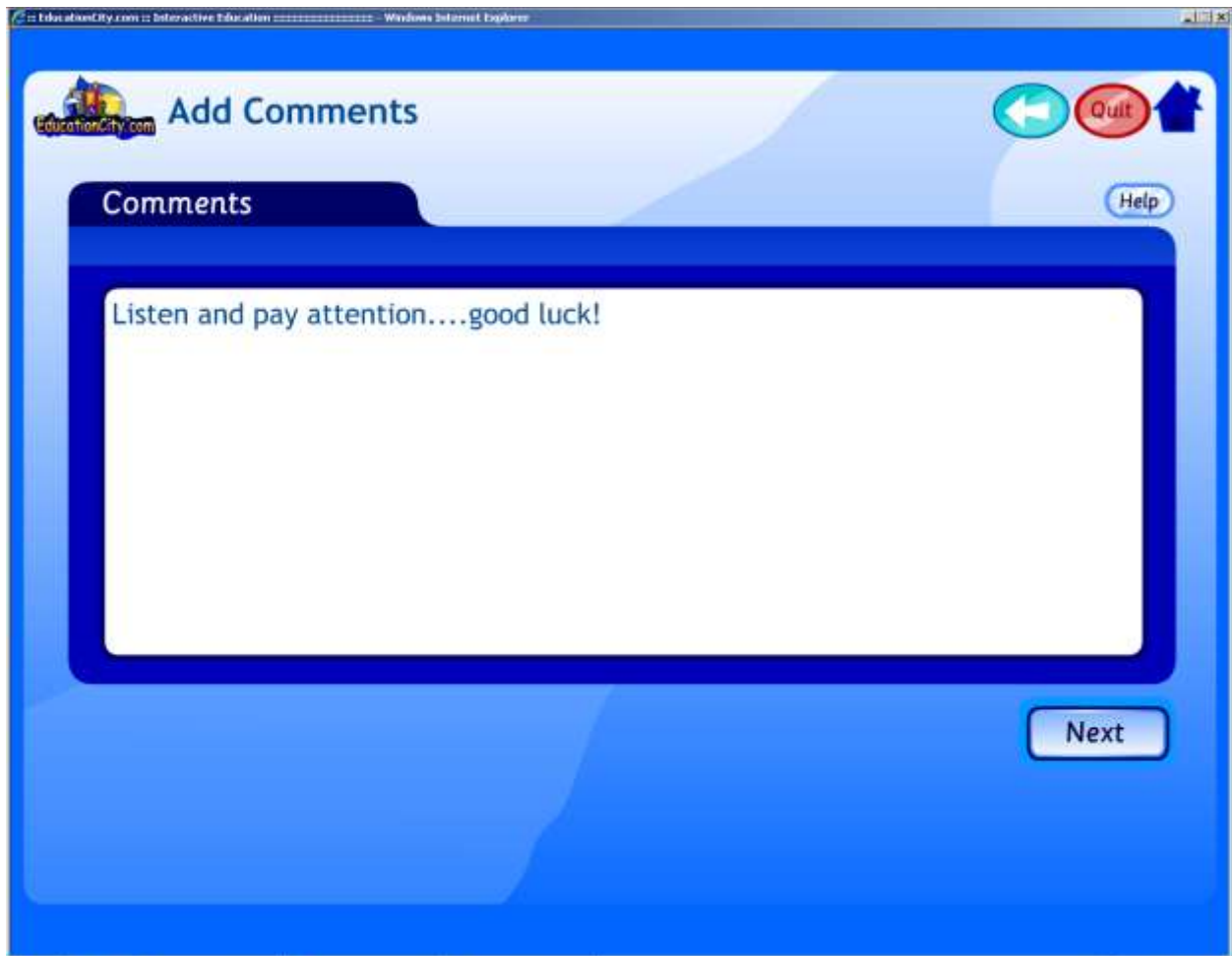
