## ACCESSING THE KEYSTONE EXAMS FROM SASD PCs

### Purpose

This documentation illustrates how to access the PDE Keystone Exams from Sayre Area School District PCs.

### Background on PDE Keystone Exams

PDE Keystone Exams need to have PDE software installed on SASD PCs.

Additionally, the PDE Keystone Exams need to have a specific screen resolution set on the SASD PCs in order to work.

### Background on the Installation of Software / Configuration

When a teacher or student logs in to a HS Lab or Teacher PC, the following takes place (only requires one log on):

1. PDE Keystone Software is installed
2. QRes Software is installed (program needed to change screen resolution)
3. Shortcut is copied to PC (as long as items 1 and 2 are completed)
4. When the program is run (QRes runs to set the resolution to 1024 by 768) – then it starts up the Keystone Software

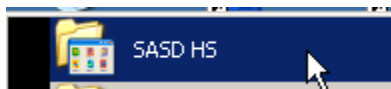
### Accessing the Keystone Exams

Where can the Keystone Exams be accessed? **From any of the HS Labs, HS Library, HS Classroom PCs, Teacher PCs (please note that this software can not be accessed from the wireless laptops).**

To access the software:

Click on Start – click on SASD HS – click on Keystone Exam – PA Online Assessments (Keystone Exam)
