## FIREFOX – WORKING AROUND INTERNET EXPLORER PROBLEMS

### Purpose

Sometimes you may be on a web site that does not work quite right using Internet Explorer.

The following are 2 sample problems:

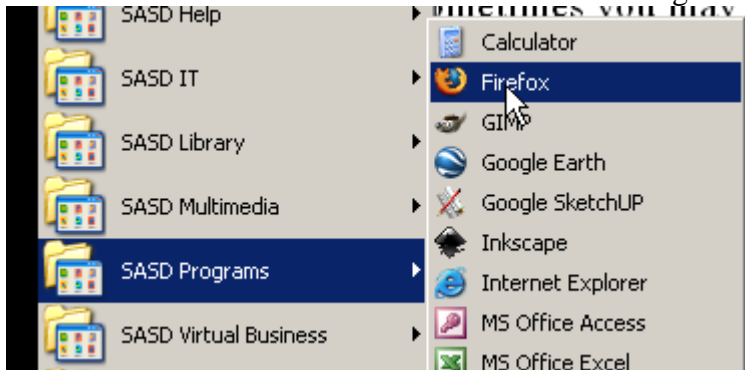
The Jostens web site for the Yearbook does not work correctly in Internet Explorer.

Another example is some Adobe PDF files will not print properly in Internet Explorer (in this case the print out looks like a bunch of random numbers and characters).

To work around these problems – just give Firefox a try.

### How Do Use Firefox?

Click on the Start Button – then click the SASD Programs – then click on Firefox



If this is the first time starting Firefox – select yes to Import Bookmarks and other settings – click on No (to make this your default browser)



You will see the following sample screen:  
Now just navigate to the desired website and work as normal.
