HTML – TESTING WEB PAGES WITH DIFFERENT WEB BROWSERS

Purpose

This handout is to briefly instruct how to test your HTML Web Pages using a variety of web browsers.

Why Use a Variety of Web Browsers?

Testing your web pages with a variety of Web Browsers ensures that your web pages can be viewed correctly no matter what web browser the user is utilizing.

How do I Get Different Web Browsers on my Computer?

It is relatively simple to get different web browsers on your computer. The basic steps are:

1. Go to the appropriate web site (ex. www.opera.com)
2. Download the browser (using the appropriate link)
3. Install the browser

What are some of the Most Common Browsers?

Microsoft Internet Explorer (www.microsoft.com). Is the most widely used browser and works on PCs.

Firefox (www.firefox.com). Nice alternative to Internet Explorer that works on PC Windows, Linux, and Apple computers.

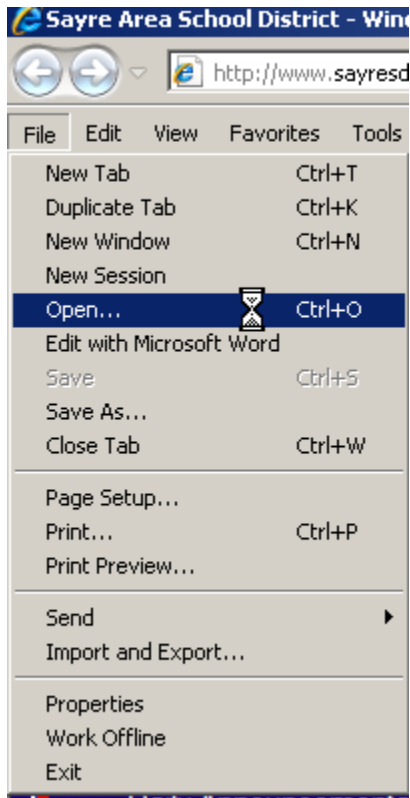
Opera (www.opera.com). Small sized browser that is relatively fast.

Safari (<http://www.apple.com/safari/download/>). Apples browser that works on MACs and PCs.

How Do I Test My HTML Pages with Other Browsers?

This is relatively simple – just start up another web browser

Click on the File (menu) – then click on Open



Browse

Navigate to where your HTML files are stored
