## What is ESP?

Mansfield's ESP (Early Start Program) allows qualified Pennsylvania high school students to take Mansfield University courses – in online, hybrid, or face-to-face formats – and earn college credits while still enrolled in high school.

## Which Courses Can I Take?

The appropriate courses are determined collaboratively by the university and the participating school districts. Typically, courses in Art History, Business, Communication, Criminal Justice, English, History, Mathematics, Philosophy, and Sociology, among others, are offered. Course registration is on a space-available basis. Subject areas listed above are not necessarily available each semester.

## When Are the Courses Offered?

Selected courses are available each Fall and Spring semester and during our Summer I (SU) and Summer II (SF) terms.



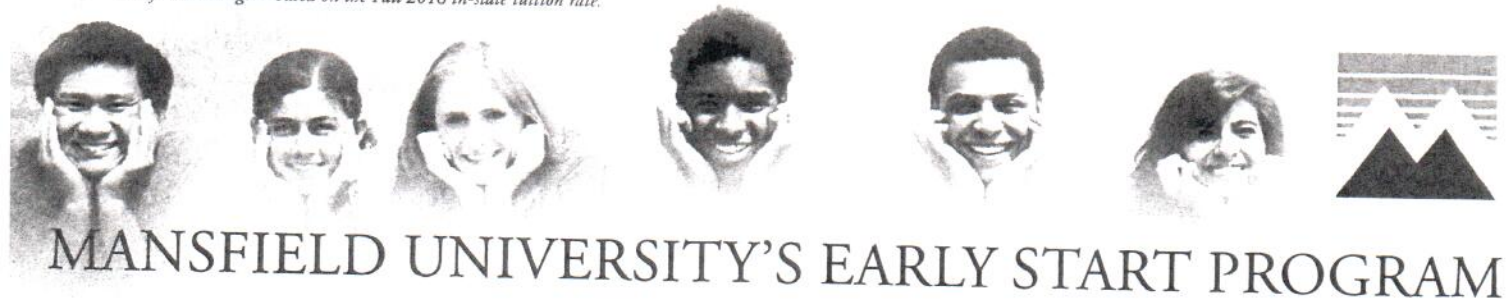
