Note: This statement shall become invalid at the close of the school year. A new affidavit will need to be instituted before admission to the Sayre School District for the next school year.

Per 24 P.S. § 13- 1302, a person who knowingly provides false information in the above statement for the purpose of enrolling a child in a school district for which the child is not eligible commits a summary offense and shall, upon conviction for such violation, be sentenced to pay a fine for no more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00) for the benefit of the school district in which the person resides or to perform up to two hundred forty (240) hours of community service, or both. In addition, the person shall pay all court costs and shall be liable to the school district for an amount equal to the cost of tuition calculated in the accordance with § 2561 during the period of enrollment.
